A bright pale straw colour with a persistent mousse.

The nose is fresh with strawberry fruit, a touch of creamy yeast and grassiness.

Palate

The delicate fruit characters follow through onto the palate with a touch of biscuit and fresh dough. The finish is long and elegant with a refreshing crisp, citrus finish.
